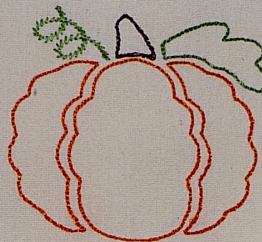

Make your own towels with the following unique fabrics:

- #1 - Osnaburg cloth (Available at Joann Fabrics [HERE](#))
- #2 - Waffle Weave cotton also known as Honeycomb Fabric Material (Available at Joann Fabrics [HERE](#))
- #3 - Cotton Drop Cloth (I purchased mine from Harbor Freight)
- #4 – Ready made towel (Dunroven brand)

My favorite sizes for crating towels from fabric yardage:

- Large: 20-inches wide X 28-inches long
Cut 22-inches wide X 30-inches long
- Small: 18-inches wide X 25-inches long
Cut 20-inches wide X 27-inches long

When making towels from scratch, use double turned ½-inch hem on all edges. Options: Use selvedge for top edge instead of hemming, trim bottom with lace or fabric band.
